Who Can Enter?	<p>The competition is open to all Apprentices that are registered with their Provincial Apprenticeship Office, except previous first place winners of this competition.</p> <p>There is no limit to the number of apprentices that an employer can enter.</p>
Is There A Fee?	<p>Entry is FREE for all Apprentices.</p>
Is There A Time Limit?	<p>No time limits have been set for the test piece; however, an accurate report of the time taken to manufacture the test piece <u>must</u> be submitted with the entry. Although time will be taken into account when judging the entries, the demonstrated skills are of prime importance. Your Entry Package will include detailed "Instructions & Information", any special rules and an outline of the judging criteria.</p>
How Do I Enter?	<p>Simply complete and submit a Registration Form by APRIL 30, 2009 to the CTMA office. We will send an Entry Package to you that will contain the test piece drawing, your own unique Part Number, instructions, special rules, judging criteria, and other information that you will need to produce and submit the competition test piece.</p>
What Is The Deadline?	<p>All completed test pieces and supporting documentation are to be shipped prepaid to the CTMA office at 140 McGovern Drive, Unit #3, Cambridge, ON N3H 4R7 to arrive no later than 4:00 p.m. JULY 31st, 2009.</p>
When Are Awards Presented?	<p>Winning Apprentices and their Employers will be presented with their awards and prizes at the association's Annual General Meeting being held on September 16th, 2009 at the Elm Hurst Inn, Ingersoll, Ontario.</p>
